## Ministry Accounts

June Quarter Ministry Accounts are due by **7th July 2017**. As this is the last report for the Financial Year, all reports must be in on time, no exceptions. This will enable us to meet our legal obligations. Please also ensure that your account is balanced to the closing balance of your account as at 30th June 2017. If you are not balanced please contact the National Office for assistance, do not submit an unbalanced report.

## Employer Super Fund Members

A reminder for super fund members, that if you are intending to qualify for the government co-contribution, you need to make the relevant contribution before the end of the financial year. The maximum co-contribution is \$500, and to qualify \$1,000 needs to be contributed as a personal contribution to super if assessable income is not more than \$36,021. If income is between \$36,021 and \$51,021 a prorata co-contribution is paid based on income and contribution amount. I have attached a link to the ATO that has eligibility criteria and a calculator for the co-contribution.
