CAMBODIA

A walk through the relics and monuments of the Angkor Archaeological Park remind us of the powerful and unified Khmer Empire of the 11th Century. Today, Cambodians are proud of their heritage, and although modern history reminds of the devastation and genocide that this nation has suffered, you will readily find the Khmer people to be optimistic, joyful and resilient.

In July this year, Dreambuilders Network gathered an Impact Team from Churches in Darwin, Devonport and Malaga. We based ourselves in Phnom Penh.



To set the tone for the visit, the team were invited to attend both the Choeng Ek Killing Fields and the Toul Sleng Genocide Museum. This experience was emotional and left no room for questioning the great need for Christ in Cambodia.

It was a privilege to meet Chinhho Saing. We spent time getting to know Chinhho and his family, and at one time, heard his testimony and heart for the church. Chinhho founded Shalom Mission Cambodia (www.smCambodia.org) and outlined his



vision to transform Cambodia through church planting, leadership development and community development.

One such community development strategy is the Shalom International School. We gladly invested four days of labour to clear a path for site works to continue at the school so that trucks could gain access to the rear of the property to commence the process of back filling against the newly erected retaining walls.



You see, in November 2016, the infrastructure at the rear of the school washed away into the adjacent river.

The ongoing challenge for Shalom Mission Cambodia is to raise funds to complete the site works at the school and commence the erection of new classrooms to replace the ones that had been undermined by the flood waters. Please pray for Shalom International

School. Principal Soriya has a faithful team of teachers and volunteers at the school who have a love for the students and a desire to excel in their vocation.
